



Tri-Ko, Inc. CDDO State Aid Allocation Protocol

Purpose: The Tri-Ko, Inc. Community Developmental Disability Organization (CDDO) – through its contract with the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) – receives an annual allocation of State Aid funds made in quarterly payments for the purpose of providing Intellectual/Developmental Disability services in the CDDO service area of Miami, Linn and Anderson counties.

Protocol:

- 1) Persons previously funded for Day Supports and Adult Residential Supports through the State General Funds (SGF) grant as of FY2011 will be allocated State Aid to continue those services. These persons were determined Home & Community Based Services (HCBS) ineligible when the SGF was discontinued in FY2011 and the State Aid allocation allows them to continue receiving necessary services.
- 2) State Aid funding is additionally allocated for transportation expenses that are not reimbursed.
- 3) Due to the funding shortfall, additional persons cannot be granted access to State Aid funds until the amount of funding available exceeds the total for a full year's worth of service units for each person in Day Supports and Adult Residential Supports previously funded through the SGF grant. However, persons may apply for State Aid funds through the CDDO at any time and be added to a waiting list for available funds.
- 4) Each person funded for Day Supports and Adult Residential Supports through State Aid is given their service options annually at the time of their Functional Assessment.
